English

In writing, we will continue to cover a wide range of genre to exhibit our excellent writing skills and use of new and ambitious vocabulary and extended punctuation.

In preparation for the Reading, and the Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar SATs paper, please ensure your children complete their weekly homework.

Maths

In maths, we will be focusing on applying all our knowledge and skills to problem solving in various forms in preparation for the tests. We also ask that children continue to practice their times tables on TT Rockstars – rapid recall of their tables is extremely important for all areas of the mathematics curriculum.

Foundation

After SATs, Year 6 will be completing wider curriculum topics, which will include artwork, history, geography and poetry.

Production

Once the SATs are over, we will begin learning and practising our production. The children will have lines and songs that they need to learn.

It is **vital** all Year 6 children come to school EVERY DAY to ensure the best possible outcomes for your children. The SATs tests begin on **Monday 12th May**. **We will be in class from 8.20am Mon-Thurs and breakfast snacks will be available.** We strongly recommend **all Year 6 attend SATs breakfast club** – it helps the children stay calm and chat with friends before tests start.

Uniform

Please ensure that children are wearing the correct uniform at all times:

- Navy blue pinafore dress, navy blue skirt
- Navy blue or dark grey tailored school trousers
- White school shirt
- Navy blue 'V' neck jumper or cardigan with school logo which must be on the left side of the chest
- Tie - traditional only
- White, dark or navy socks (no logos or motifs)
- Black low-heeled school shoes
- P.E. – plain blue, black or white t-shirt and shorts/tracksuit bottoms, plain trainers/plimsolls
