We will start the term by learning about *Global Citizenship* and what it means to a global citizen in the 21st century. We learn about the importance of recognizing oneself as part of a worldwide community and understanding that actions and choices have impacts on a global scale. Our learning involves an awareness of global issues like climate change, inequality, human rights, a commitment to fostering peace and sustainability, and the ability to engage respectfully with diverse cultures.

IPC – Our first topic is 'Brainwaves' where we will be learning about metacognition followed by 'Existing, Endangered, Extinct' where we will be exploring evolution and inheritance.

In **English**, we will be reading 'Rooftoppers' by Katherine Rundell. We will also learn about writing autobiographies.



Our **Maths** focus in Autumn 1 is place value, the four operations and fractions. Please ensure your child gets their Times Table Rockstars login from their teacher and logs on regularly as this will be monitored. Certificates can be earned for those who are topping the tables for the most time spent on TT Rockstars at home.

Uniform
