To understand the positive and negative impacts of people's actions (including own personal choices) on others and the environment To know how people can damage or improve the environment

To know the causes of disagreement and conflict at personal, classroom and household levels To know some ways of avoiding, managing and resolving conflict

To be able to consider merits of different viewpoints

To be able to show interest in, and concern for, others outside immediate circle and in contexts different to own

To be able to identify matters that are important to self and others

To be able to learn from mistakes and use feedback

To be able to state opinions and start to give reasons for these To be able to listen carefully to others

To be able to play and work cooperatively
To be able to help to ensure that everyone in own group is included

To be able to have sense of self-worth and worth of others

Commitment to social justice and equity

To be able to develop a willingness to stand up and speak up for others To understand how to deal with others fairly

Respect for people and human rights

To be able to respect for the rights of others

To know the belief that everyone has equal rights

Value diversity

To understand how to value others as equal and different

To know how to listen respectfully to the ideas and views of others even when one disagrees

Concern for the environment

To be able to show concern about the local environment and willingness to care for it

To understand how to take care of resources and not wasting them

To understand how fairness may not always mean equal treatment

To be able to give examples of what it can mean to be rich or poor in local and other contexts

Identity and diversity

To understand contributions of different cultures to our lives To understand the nature of prejudice, racism and sexism and ways to combat these

Globalisation

To be able to identify links between local community and wider world To be able to make global connections between peoples and countries (e.g. through trade and communications)

Sustainable development

To understand the basics of climate change (causes and effects)

Peace and conflict

To know some strategies for managing, resolving and preventing conflict, including 'win-win' solutions

Power and governance

To understand the need for rules in own school and wider society and how people can take part in making and changing them

Critical and creative thinking

To be able to give evidence for an argument, assess different viewpoints and present counterarguments

To be able to imagine alternative possibilities and suggest new ideas to solve problems

Empathy

To be able to adapt behaviour to take into account feelings of others

Self-awareness and reflection

To be able to explore reasons for negative feelings towards others and in new or difficult situations

Communication

To be able to participate in discussions about issues that affect self, others and the wider world To be able to listen attentively, question and respond to others

Cooperation and conflict resolution

To be able to work cooperatively to solve problems or achieve goals
To be able to use strategies to manage anger, frustration and aggressive feelings

Sense of identity and self-esteem

To be able to have a sense of belonging and valuing of relationships with others To be able to develop an awareness of, and pride in, own individuality

To be able to develop offence at unfair treatment of others locally and globally

Respect for people and human rights

To be able to develop a readiness to think through consequences of words, actions and choices on others

Value diversity

To be able to recognise the benefits of listening to a range of different perspectives and viewpoints

To be able to learn from the experiences of others

Concern for the environment

To be able to have a sense of responsibility for the environment and the use of resources
