
A message about Reception

In this topic, we will be learning about the different festivals and celebrations people may enjoy and the different traditions people may have. We will be learning about a variety of celebrations such as bonfire night, Diwali and Christmas.

We will be continuing our phonics, reading, writing and maths teaching through targeted whole class sessions. We will be continuing to follow the Little Wandle programme for phonics in which we will be particularly focusing on their blending (reading) and segmenting (spelling) skills. In Maths, we will be following the White Rose scheme of work. This half term our maths focuses will include recognising, representing and composing numbers 1-5.

Homework

Children will receive a half termly homework project. This half term we would like the children to bring in photos and/or drawings of the different festivals and celebrations they take part in at home. We would also like the children to practise the different sounds we have learnt over the course of the half term.
