Reading

Writing


We begin this term with writing formal letters, looking at the structure and language used, as well as the difference between main and subordinate clauses.

Then, we will be writing dialogue through a narrative, writing in the past tense and using the third person perspective.

We finish the term with performance poetry, looking at alliteration, rhyme and repetition.

In maths we will begin by deepening our understanding of addition and subtraction and introducing multiplication and division. We also ask that children continue to practice their times tables on TT Rockstars.

Wider curriculum



In RE we will be discussing the question "What does it mean to be a Christian in Britain today?" They will be finding out what Christians may do at home, in church and in the wider community and why these things are important to them.

In PSHE our topic is "Celebrating Difference" the children will learn about families and how they are all different. They will learn techniques to understand their feelings, techniques to calm themselves down and solve problems effectively. They also learn about giving and receiving compliments and the feelings associated with this.

Our **P.E.** focus this term is World Sports & Multi Skills

In **Spanish** this term the children will be learning about animals.
