PSHE – Being me in my world

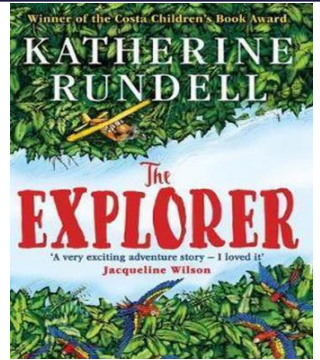
IPC – Space scientists and Art

Homework
