


A Message from the SEND resource provision

Hello and welcome to our Spring 1 half term!

We hope you all had a wonderful and restful break. This half term, our exciting topic is **“To Infinity & Beyond!”**, where we will be blasting off into space to explore planets, rockets and imaginative alien adventures. We will be diving into stories such as *‘Aliens Love Underpants’*, *‘Zoom Rocket Zoom’* and *‘Alien School’* to inspire curiosity, creativity and play.



Communication and Language: We will continue to enjoy nursery rhymes, action songs and listening to engaging stories. Through Attention Autism sessions and exploring a sensory story bag, children will practise responding to and following simple instructions.

We will encourage them to ask questions about what they have seen or heard, understand simple who, what and when questions, and use our Makaton communication method to deepen their understanding of this term’s topic.



Physical and Sensory Development: Children will develop movement and balancing skills, using and remembering simple sequences and patterns of movement.

Literacy and Phonics: When being read to, children will respond to questions that require simple recall and practise retelling short sequences of events by sequencing images or objects. They will join in with predictable phrases in stories. In phonics, we will explore the sounds u, r, h, b, f, l, j, developing skills to both identify initial sounds and articulate sounds clearly.

Mathematics: Through number songs, counting rhymes and hands-on activities, children will find, subitise and represent numbers. We will explore one more and one less, revisit the days of the week and investigate mass, capacity and height.



We’re looking forward to an exciting half term filled with discovery, imagination and space-themed fun!
