

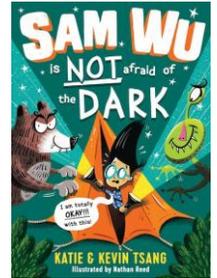


### A Message from Year 3

#### Reading

Our reading text this half term begins with “Not Afraid of the Dark”, This book sits somewhere between a picture book and a graphic novel. The book centres around Sam Wu trying to prove that he is not afraid of the dark which proves challenging when he is sent on a camping trip. It forms part of a series of books about conquering fears.



#### Writing

We begin this term with writing both first and third person narratives and descriptions. Then, we will be writing non-chronological reports. Finally completing advanced instructional writing.

#### Maths

In maths we will begin by deepening our understanding of multiplication and division. To support this we ask that children regularly practise their times tables on TT Rockstars.

#### Wider curriculum

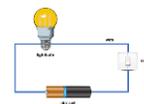
Our **Science** topic this term is called “ “Shake it!.” We will be learning about electricity. We will also be learning about solids, liquids and gases and how things can change state. We will need to be scientists to investigate the chemistry of some cooking and preparation processes.

In **RE** we will be discussing the question “Why do people pray?” The children will learn in depth from different religions about prayer: the practice, symbols, words and significance of prayer, so that they can develop thoughtful ideas and viewpoints about prayer.

In **PSHE** our topic is “Dreams and Goals ” the children will be discussing their aspirations, how to achieve goals and understanding the different emotions that come with this.

Our **P.E.** focus this term is gymnastics and invasion games.

In **Spanish** this term the children will be learning about numbers and colours.
