Hello and welcome to our Spring 2 half term!

Hope you all had a lovely week at home. We are now half way through the academic year! This half term, our topic is **“Traditional Tales!”**, where we will be focusing on a different story each week: The Gingerbread Man, The Three Little Pigs, Goldilocks & the 3 Bears, Jack & the Beanstalk and Little Red Riding Hood.



Communication and Language:

This term, children will be supported to communicate using Makaton signs and their individual AAC books. Children will be encouraged to make choices, requests and respond to simple *who, when and where* questions using their preferred method of communication.



Social, Emotional and Mental Health:

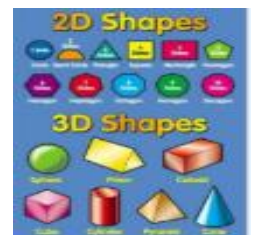
We will support children to build positive relationships by encouraging turn-taking, sharing and interacting with peers, with adult support as needed. Daily routines will help build confidence and independence. Using Zones of Regulation, children will begin to label simple emotions and practise basic strategies to support self-regulation.

Literacy and Phonics:

Children will be supported to engage with stories by joining in with predictable phrases and talking about key events. Phonics sessions will focus on identifying initial sounds and oral blending. Writing opportunities will encourage children to form letters and write simple words or captions using sounds they know.

Mathematics:

Through number songs and practical activities, children will develop their understanding of number as well as exploring 2D & 3D shapes, learning to name and describe their features.



We are looking forward to a positive half term filled with shared stories, familiar songs and meaningful communication opportunities.
