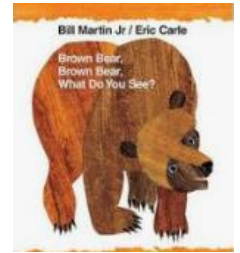


A Message from the SEND resource provision

Hello and welcome to our Summer 1 half term!

Hope you all had a lovely Easter Break!
 This half term, our topic is **“Creatures Great & Small!”**, where we will be focusing on a different story each week. These include: The Little Red Hen, Brown Bear Brown Bear & The Very Hungry Caterpillar.



Communication and Language:

This term, children will be encouraged to respond to and follow simple instructions with up to three key words and answer simple *who*, *what*, *when* and *where* questions. They will continue to develop their use of Makaton and build their vocabulary by talking about things that interest them, as well as beginning to ask simple questions of their own.

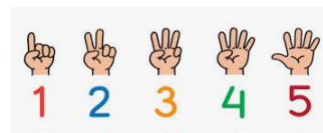
Social, Emotional and Mental Health:

Children will be supported to continue building positive relationships with their peers by practising turn-taking and beginning to share during play with minimal adult support. We will encourage children to develop confidence and independence through daily routines and opportunities to recognise their own achievements.



Literacy and Phonics:

Children will continue to engage with stories by retelling parts of the story, they will join in with predictable phrases and refrains during shared reading. Phonics sessions will introduce new sounds including **ck, x, sh, th, ng and nk**. Writing opportunities will support children to form many lower-case letters correctly.



Mathematics:

Through number songs, rhymes and practical activities, children will continue to develop their understanding of number. They will practise counting and begin exploring simple addition and taking away using real objects.
