Our learning this term

In the build-up to SATs, our learning this term will be heavily focused on revision in reading, grammar and mathematics. In addition, the children will continue with their narrative writing and PSHE.

As a school, we have begun a rewards system for each class, using a 'hundred square'. When the class show outstanding effort and behaviours as a class, they are awarded a tick on their chart. When they reach one hundred ticks, we will have a whole-class reward. Our reward will be to go to the park for the afternoon.



Revision

Any revision that can be carried out at home, ahead of the SATs, would be very beneficial to the children. Uniform

Please ensure that children are wearing the correct uniform at all times:

- Navy blue pinafore dress, navy blue skirt
- Navy blue or dark grey tailored school trousers
- White school polo shirt
- Navy blue round neck jumper or cardigan with school logo which must be on the left side of the chest
- White or dark socks or navy blue tights
- Black low-heeled school shoes (no logos or motifs) or black trainers – these must be all black, no colours/logos.
